1. Introduction

2. Services

3. Pricing

Prices are displayed in pounds sterling (£).

Prices may change without notice but confirmed bookings will not be affected.

4. Payment

Payment terms are set out in the Booking & Cancellation Policy or agreed in writing before the booking.

5. Participant Responsibilities

Participants agree to:

- Treat others with respect.
- Follow reasonable instructions.
- Use equipment safely.
- Respect the venue and its facilities.

The Opaque Elephant reserves the right to end a participant's involvement if behaviour places others at risk or seriously disrupts the workshop.
